

Agenda for the inaugural PVA Committee meeting on 19 July 2018 at 7pm

3. Review the initial goals approved at the village meeting

 - First aid courses
 - Social events (a pop up bar is proposed)
4. The village defibrillator is to be installed at Woodlands Farm Barns on an exterior wall. Training to be made available to the village. Progressing this ASAP to use the green fund monies (£1,000) held in the church account.
5. Supporting the creation of a glamping unit and multifunctional space in the church. How is the unit to be managed and volunteers organised.
6. A children's play/nativity for the carol service to be discussed.
7. A dedicated PVA page has been added to the village website which will hold all agendas, minutes of meetings, events and news.
8. Does the village need a neighbourhood watch scheme?
